

POOL OPENS FRIDAY MAY 22nd at 4:30pm Ice cream social starts at 5pm

The last day of school for Cobb County is Friday, May 22nd. For those of you new to the neighborhood, this means the pool will finally be open for the swim season.

If you moved into the neighborhood within the last twelve months please come to the pool on Friday May 22nd from 5pm to 8pm to receive your pool badge and key. These items are no charge to new residents. If you have lost your key, you may buy a replacement for \$5.00.

Please remember:

- Bring your pool badges with you each time you come to swim.
- Absolutely NO glass allowed in the pool. Please be considerate of others and bring plastic cups if your favorite beverage is only available in a glass container.
- Swim diapers are mandatory for children not potty trained. Cobb County requires that a pool be closed a minimum of 24 hours if the water is contaminated. E-Coli is serious.

Friday May 22 thru Sunday September 6; week-end schedule

- Saturday 11am -9pm
- Sunday 12pm - 9pm

Week day schedule: Monday – Friday, 11 -9

Starting August 8th, week-ends only:

- August & September on Saturday 11am - 9pm, last Saturday is the 5th of September
- August & September on Sunday 12pm – 9pm last Sunday is the 6th of September
- Labor Day Monday, September 7, 2009: 11am – 9pm is the last day of swim season
